## *Local Author Publishes a Book of Virginia's Evangelistic Revival Journey from the 1700's*

Dorothy "Dot" Dalton, a long-time resident of Suffolk, announces the publishing of her compiled historical book "Rekindle Virginia. The Flames of Revival".

Dalton is well known in this area for founding and leading IMPACT SUFFOLK from 1995-2011. IMPACT coordinated several "March for Jesus" rallies, Summer Slam for Youth, a city-wide play "Heaven's Gates & Hell's Flames" for 3 consecutive different years, as well as many food give a ways, and monthly community prayer meetings.

Her desire is to share the original Virginia revival journey as walked by Francis Asbury. The book includes:

1. Leaders of the Protestant Reformation in Europe, then England, and on to Jamestown by the Anglicans with the Church of England.
2. The importance of the First Virginia Charter of 1606, purpose (propagate the Gospel to the natives), land area (from Bermuda to the west coast, and from today's South Carolina to Canada), and primary author Rev. Richard Hakluyt.
3. The Early protestant denominations in Virginia.

Dalton discovered that the second Great Awakening in America was in Virginia (1740-1790) after the New England Awakening with Jonathan Edwards and refreshed by George Whitefield in the 1730's. The book shows maps of awakening counties of the Virginia Great Awakening of the early denominations of Anglican, Presbyterian, Methodist, German/Dutch Reformers, and Baptists.
